# TENNIS RULES

- 1. **Tennis Court Reservations & Guest Registration –** Only members and their registered guests are entitled to use the tennis area.
  - a. Courts may be reserved (adults only) by calling the Tennis Pro Shop or on CourtReserve. Reservations may be made up to one week in advance. The courts will be held until 15 minutes after the reserved time and then will be released for general play. Tournament play will have priority.
  - b. All players must sign in with the Pro Shop attendant before entering the court. Members MUST register guests in the Pro Shop before play or register their guests on CourtReserve.

#### 2. Guest Fees

- a. There is a \$10 guest fee for tennis court usage. The fee is \$10 per guest regardless of the day of the week (Tuesday-Sunday or holidays) and whether it is a family guest or not.
- **3. Limitations** The limit on play time is one-and-a-half (1.5) hours for singles and two (2) hours for doubles if other players are waiting.
  - a. Children under 18 years of age are not to use the courts after 4:00 p.m. on weekdays or at any time on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays when adults are waiting to play.
  - b. Other than taking a tennis lesson or participating in an HCC sanctioned tennis event, dependents under the age of twelve (12) must be accompanied by a parent or adult member when using the tennis facilities.
  - c. Children of all ages are not permitted to play (non-tennis activities) on or near the tennis facilities at any time, which includes the patio area overlooking the tennis courts, which is reserved for members using the tennis facilities.
  - d. Tennis professional approval is required if a member has more than three (3) guests. There must be a member on each court.
  - e. A member's grandchildren may generally participate in the junior tennis program. Grandchildren participants are entitled to use HCC tennis facilities for all clinics and program sponsored events. Grandchildren may also utilize the Club's tennis facilities for a period of one hour prior to and after the conclusion of tennis clinics or events; or may sign in as a guest with the accompaniment of a member. All other membership limitations apply for extended or additional visits.
  - f. HCC is closed on Mondays with the exception of tennis, pickleball and the fitness facility.

### 4. Dress

- a. Only approved tennis apparel shall be worn during play. Cut-off jeans and swimsuits are not permitted. Players must wear shirts.
- b. Tank tops or muscle shirts for men are not permitted.
- c. Under no circumstances is any player allowed to play without approved soft court tennis shoes.
- d. No running, track shoes are allowed or shoes with spikes.

**5. Authority of Tennis Professional -** The tennis professional shall have supervision and control of the tennis area, subject to the oversight of the Tennis Committee. Orders and directions of the tennis professional must be followed by members and their guests.

# PICKLEBALL RULES

- **1. Pickleball Court Reservations & Guest Registration -** Only members and their registered guests are entitled to use the pickleball area.
  - a. Courts may be reserved (adults only) by calling the Tennis Pro Shop or on CourtReserve. Reservations may be made up to one week in advance. The courts will be held until 15 minutes after the reserved time and then will be released for general play. Tournament play will have priority.
  - b. All players must sign in with the Pro Shop attendant before entering the court. Members MUST register guests in the Pro Shop before play or register their guests on CourtReserve.

### 2. Guest Fees

- a. There is a \$10 guest fee for pickleball court usage. The fee is \$10 per guest regardless of the day of the week (Tuesday-Sunday or holidays) and whether it is a family guest or not.
- **3. Limitations** The limit on play time is one-and-a-half (1.5) hours for singles and two (2) hours for doubles if other players are waiting.
  - a. Children under 18 years of age are not to use the courts after 4:00 p.m. on weekdays or at any time on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays when adults are waiting to play.
  - b. Other than taking a pickleball lesson or participating in an HCC sanctioned pickleball event, Dependents under the age of twelve (12) must be accompanied by a parent or adult member when using the pickleball facilities.
  - c. Children of all ages are not permitted to play (non-pickleball activities) on or near the pickleball courts at any time.
  - d. Pickleball professional approval is required if a member has more than three (3) guests. There must be a member on each court.
  - e. HCC is closed on Mondays with the exception of tennis, pickleball and the fitness facility.

#### 4. Dress

- a. Only approved pickleball apparel shall be worn during play. Cut-off jeans and swimsuits are not permitted. Players must wear shirts.
- b. Tank tops or muscle shirts for men are not permitted.
- c. Non-marking shoes are to be worn. No running or track shoes are allowed.
- **5. Authority of Pickleball Professional -** The pickleball professional shall have supervision and control of the pickleball area, subject to the oversight of the Tennis Committee. Orders and directions of the pickleball professional must be followed by members and their guests.
